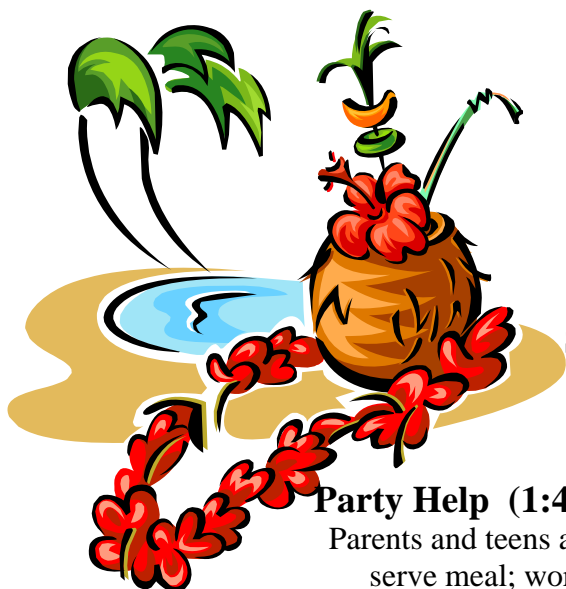
Can we count on your help this year?
